wuqanqankimik will take place in all SD8 Kootenay Lake schools. wuqanqankimik is a ktunaxa word that means "to walk with long strides...to take big steps." Canyon-Lister School is holding our walk on Monday June 20, which is National Indigenous Day. We will have different length routes, and students will be run/walking on school grounds (combo of forest and front field, etc).

The student laptop pilot program will not be implemented in 22-23 as a result of budget constraints. Laptops already leased will be integrated in schools across the district to improve equity and access to technology, supporting all students' learning and to ensure accessibility for all students.
