2022/2023 Kindergarten registration now open

Kindergarten registration for the 2022/23 school year is now open. Children who turn 5 by December 31st, 2022 are eligible to register. To register, you need to fill out a student registration form, available at the school office or at the link found here: https://www.sd8.bc.ca/kindergarten-registration . Also required is the child's birth certificate, MSP carecard, and proof of residence (ie utility bill, passport, driver's license).

FAQ's about Out-of-catchment student transfers

For students who plan to attend a school that is not in their catchment area:

- Transfer forms & Registrations will be accepted from January 4, 2022 to March 25, 2022 at 4:00 PM.
- Transfer forms only need to be completed by students transferring to a school that is not in their catchment area.
- To be considered for the September 4, 2022 start day, Student Transfer forms must be received by March 25, 2022 at 4:00 pm; the completed form must be sent to your catchment school for principal's signature, catchment principal will send the form to requested school clerical
- All transfer requests received by this date will be considered for the 2022-2023 school year and families will be notified prior to the end of the school year;
- Student Transfers received after the March 25, 2022 deadline will not be considered until after September 9, 2022 (first Friday after school starts);
- NOTE: Student transfer forms are no longer required for students who have been attending an out of catchment school or an independent school, but who wish to attend their "in catchment" school for 2022-2023. However, registration forms and applicable information will be required;
- Out of catchment Students wishing to attend a school, where their sibling attends, will be prioritized before other "out of catchment" students wishing to attend

Morning reminders

As spring approaches, we want to remind all families that morning supervision does not begin until 8:00 am. Therefore, please do not drop off students prior to 8:00 am.

Also, for those students who are dropped off by vehicle in the morning, there are specific locations for this.

- Please do not enter the bus lane (the lane closest to the school) at any time.
- Use the other lane and <u>stop at the crosswalk sign</u> (near the gym entrance) to let your child out of the vehicle- this is where students cross the lane safely, and with a sign. Ensure there is no vehicle in the bus lane before you let your child out.

This lane is for <u>drop-off only</u>. If you wish to walk your child to the school door, you need to park in a parking spot (at the field or behind the gym) so that traffic can continue to flow.

 Please do not drop your child off at any other location- there are vehicles coming through, and children need to cross at one specific, marked crossing.
